Outpatient Therapy

- Refers to people coming into the office for therapy appointments
- Offered both in person and via telehealth
- Individual, Family, Couples, Group
- All ages
- Typically, an hour every week, or every other week, though may be less frequent as people are working their way out
- Offered in all of our counties



Youth Services

- School-Linked Behavioral Health Services
 - Therapy
 - Skills
- Intensive In-Home
- CTSS Individual and Family Skills
- CTSS Group Skills
- Youth and Adolescent Day Treatment



Integrated Care

- Behavioral Health Home (BHH)
 - Care Coordination
 - Support improved or maintained wellness for individuals diagnosed with a mental illness
 - Adults and Children
- Targeted Case Management (TCM)
 - Care Coordination
 - Resource and Referral
- Assertive Community Treatment (ACT)
 - Team provided treatment primarily to individuals with diagnoses of Psychosis
- Certified Peer Support
 - Individual (Adult)
 - Family (Child)
 - Recovery (SUD)



Crisis/Detox

- Residential Crisis
 - Adult
 - Youth (ages 6-17)
 - 24/7 admissions
- Detoxification Unit
 - 24/7 admissions
- Mobile Crisis
 - 24/7 response
- Urgent Care
 - Monday Through Friday, 8:00am to 4:00pm (Willmar, Telehealth)



Substance Use Programs

- Substance Use Group
 - Adults
 - Adolescents
- Continuing Care Program
- Substance Use Consultation
- Individual Substance Use Counseling



Medication Management

- Children and Adults
- Office and Telehealth
- Offered at all WC sites
